



## DORSET COUNTY ASA

### 2016 INTEGRATED CHAMPIONSHIPS and AGE GROUP COMPETITION

License numbers 2SW160048/2SW160049/2SW160059  
Under ASA Laws and Regulations and ASA Technical Rules of Racing

#### General Conditions:

1. The current Dorset County ASA General Competition Conditions will apply as published in the ASA South West Region Handbook and on the Dorset County ASA website, unless inconsistent with the conditions which follow. All entrants must accept these conditions.
2. Swimmers competing in any other County Association's competitions in the same year are not eligible to compete in the 2016 Integrated Championships and Age Group Competition (the Competitions), or any event covered by the Dorset General Competition Conditions.
3. The following conditions will apply to ALL swimmers entries:
  - a. All competitors must have an ASA registration number and have been registered through their Club as an ASA Category 2 swimmer. No entry will be accepted without the swimmer's current ASA registration number.
  - b. Swimmers who have applied for ASA membership and are awaiting receipt of a registration number may enter the Competitions provided a photocopy of the registration form is submitted with the entry form or the competitor's entry will not be accepted.
  - c. Swimmers with a Functional Ability Card or Certificate of Swimming Disability may enter the Competitions.
  - d. ASA or IPC Official Times must be submitted for all individual events entered.
  - e. ASA/IPC Official Times must have been achieved in an event held under ASA Laws and Regulations and ASA Technical Rules of Racing or IPC Rules from which an individual Official Time has been recorded.
  - f. All submitted entry times must have been achieved at a licensed meet (L1, L2, L3 or L4) and appear on the ASA Rankings Lists.
  - g. All submitted entries must be made using Short Course times or those converted from Long Course times using approved ASA conversion tables.
  - h. Non-ASA or IPC Official Times will not be accepted.
  - i. ASA or IPC Official Times outside of Ranx will not be accepted without the event, date and venue at which the Official Time was achieved being declared.
  - j. All ASA/IPC Official Times must be certified by an officer of the swimmer's club.
  - k. Entries received will be subject to satisfying the relevant qualifying standard as specified in the Competitions or, if space permits, the relevant consideration standard. Entry times outside of the consideration standards will not be accepted.
  - l. The Competitions are run as Integrated Competitions. Entries will be seeded on submitted times, the slowest time swimming first. Disability swimmers will compete in the appropriate time ranked heat.
  - m. The Promoter may request validation of any stated ASA or IPC Official entry time.
  - n. All Ranx entries must comply with 3(a-h) above. Non-Ranx entries from Clubs not using Ranx must ensure that the conditions stated at 3(a-h) above are given fully. Any entries not complying with 3(a-h) above or are found to be incorrect or ineligible shall be void and the entry fee forfeited.
4. All official entry times submitted must have been achieved between the first day of the preceding year's Integrated Championships and Age Group Competition and the official closing date of this year's Competitions. Submitted entry times achieved outside of this specified period will not be accepted. All entries must come from the Club Entries Officer and not individuals.
5. Entry for members of Clubs using Ranx will be by invitation in advance of the closing date. On receipt of Ranx data, Clubs will receive a schedule of invited entries for swimmers with ranked times in accordance with clauses 3(a-h) and 4 above, and the stated qualifying/consideration times. Ranx Clubs' Entries Officers are required to confirm individual entries with the Meet Co-ordinator by the official closing date of the Competitions.
6. Clubs without access to the Ranx system and ten or fewer entrants may submit manual entries on the official entry form. Clubs with/without access to Ranx with more than ten entrants and wishing to submit all club entries as manual entries will be required to submit British Swimming verification of Official Times for each entrant and will be subject to an administration fee of £15 for 50 or less entries and £15 for every 50 entries thereafter.
7. All individual entries must be received by the official closing date as a whole Club entry together with the correct entry fee and, if appropriate, the administration fee. A single cheque payable to Dorset County ASA must be sent with each Club's entry. No entries will be accepted after the official closing date.

8. Entries submitted without the correct entry fee, official invite or paper entry forms, administration fee and health declarations incorrectly completed will be returned.
9. All Clubs will receive a schedule of accepted entries immediately prior to the Competitions, the details of which should be checked and any discrepancy notified to the Meet Co-ordinator by the date specified by the Meet Co-ordinator. Discrepancies received after this date cannot be rectified. Any rejected entries will be listed. Swimmers who are not listed on the official confirmation of accepted entries will not be permitted to compete.
10. A single cheque will be made to each club for any refunds for rejected entries from that Club after completion of the Competitions.
11. Improved entry times will not be accepted after the closing date.
12. Requests for time trials will not be accepted at any time.
13. The Competitions will run with pre-seeded heats according to clause 3(k) of the General Conditions. No entry cards will be issued and no secondary registration on the day is required (see 2016 Entry Conditions clause 5d(iii) for exceptions). Empty lanes due to withdrawals on the day will remain vacant.
14. Failure to appear in the designated heat will cancel any right to compete in that event. Swimmers who have failed to appear in the designated heat may be allowed to swim in unallocated lanes in the same event at the Referee's discretion. This shall be on a first-come first-served basis.
15. All competitors will be placed with the exception of any swimmer disqualified.
16. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after the official closing date unless on medical grounds. The Meet Co-ordinator MUST be advised of intention to withdraw on medical grounds no later than seven days prior to the first day of the competitions and a medical certificate subsequently submitted to the Meet Co-ordinator no later than the last day prior to the start of the competitions. Requests for medical refunds not received seven days prior to the first day of the competitions or without a medical certificate being submitted within the specified period will not be considered.
17. The Official Promoter of the Competitions is the Dorset County ASA Swimming Committee through Mr S Platts. The Swimming Committee has set all conditions of the Competitions and any enquiries in the first instance should be directed to the Promoter via the swimmer's Club Entries Officer, as follows: Mr S Platts, 4 Kinson Grove, Bournemouth, Dorset BH10 7JA.
18. The Swimming Committee has delegated the running of the event to a Meet Co-ordinator. Entries should be sent to the Meet Co-ordinator by the applicable closing date, as follows: Mrs D Gibbs, 22 Stibbs Way, Bransgore, Christchurch, Dorset BH23 8HG.
19. The date and events for the programme of this year's Competitions are as printed in the 2016 Entry Conditions.
20. The Promoter reserves the right to alter or amend the Programme.
21. All competitors are required to observe all safety announcements and conduct themselves with safety in mind at all times. Doors will be open and warm up start approximately 45- 60 minutes before the gala is due to commence in accordance with the current published programme. Swimmers will not enter the hired area until the Referee gives permission. The Referee is responsible for all aspects of health, safety, and fair play in the area hired by DCASA and can halt the competition at any time if there are any perceived risks to the health and safety of, and fair play with regards to, competitors, officials, meet organisers or spectators.
22. Any swimmer or coach requiring wheelchair access MUST, if it is a requirement of the host leisure centre, ensure that the leisure centre approves this in advance with the swimmer or coach and a Personal Evacuation Plan is agreed with the leisure centre and submitted to the Referee prior to the start of the gala.
23. It is the responsibility of each Club's Committee to ensure that their Coach, Team Managers and Warm-Up/Warm-Down Marshals are responsible for their swimmers on the poolside, including behaviour, dress and code of conduct towards other competitors, officials and meet organisers at all times.
24. The use of a warm-down facility is made available to swimmers ONLY if supervised by one of their Club officials with a poolside pass. The facility will be withdrawn if the use is unsupervised or if deemed to be a risk to health and safety.
25. A warm-down facility may not be used for warm-up or training purposes.
26. In line with recommendations in the ASA Child Protection Policy, the Promoter requests that persons wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography from the spectator areas register their details with DCASA Staff at the spectator entry desk before carrying out such photography. Anyone not complying will be asked to leave the spectator gallery. Requests for photography on poolside must be agreed with the Promoter in advance. The leisure centre may have its own local regulations on this subject, which may supersede this condition and must be complied with.
27. Flash photography at the start of a race is prohibited. Anyone not complying will be asked to leave the spectator gallery.
28. Dorset County ASA reserves the right to take and publish still or video photography during the meet. Any request not to be photographed MUST be documented on the swimmer's Health Information Form and be received by the Promoter before the Competitions commence.

## ENTRY CONDITIONS & INFORMATION

### 1. Dates

- (a) Block 1: Saturday 20 February and Sunday 21 February 2016
- (b) Block 2: Saturday 27 February and Sunday 28 February 2016
- (c) Block 3: Saturday 5 March 2016 (800/1500m Freestyle only)
- (d) Entries closing date: Friday 22 January 2016 (mid-day)
- (e) Ranx data submissions: Friday 11 December 2015 + Friday 22 January 2016 (mid-day)

### 2. Age Groups

- (a) Age Groups will be based on age as at 31 December 2016.
- (b) Age Groups are: A (10yrs); B (11yrs); C (12yrs); D (13yrs); E (14yrs); F (15yrs); G (16yrs); H (17/o).

### 3. Entry Fees

- (a) £5.25 per event for all 50/100/200/400m events.
- (b) £6.00 per event for 800/1500m Freestyle events.

### 4. Events

As a requirement for the ASA to grant a licence for these Competitions, all events and distances are as defined by the ASA.

### 5. Entry Times

This event is a Level 2 Licensed Meet. Qualifying Times for the 2016 Competitions have been set using the ASA County (A) Qualifying Times Graded Table, and Consideration Times using the ASA National (AAA) Qualifying Times Graded Table +25% for 50m and 100m sprint events and +30% for all other events.

#### (a) County Qualifying Times

Swimmers achieving DCASA County Qualifying Times must submit entries on the official invite/entry form with the correct fee. Swimmers with Qualifying Times will be automatically entered into the competition upon receipt of entry.

#### (b) County Consideration Times

Swimmers achieving DCASA County Consideration Times must submit entries on the official invite/entry form with the correct fee. Acceptance of entries will be based on fastest submitted times and swimmers with Consideration Times will be accepted as time permits.

#### (c) Swimmers with a registered Functional Ability Card or Certificate of Swimming Disability

i. Swimmers with a registered Functional Ability computer printout or Certificate of Swimming Disability achieving DCASA Disability Consideration Times must submit entries on the official entry form with the correct fee and, for Functional Ability swimmers, their classification. Entries will be accepted as time permits.

ii. Functional Ability/Disability classification MUST be declared along with the entry time. The computer printout or certificate MUST be presented to the Referee before any swim to which it applies or Functional Ability/Disability classification cannot be recognised.

#### (d) Long distance events

i. The maximum number of heats will be limited to five (Male 1500m Freestyle) and ten (Female 800m Freestyle) respectively. Swimmers with Dorset County Qualifying Times will be automatically accepted into these events and thereafter acceptance will be based on percentage proximity to the relevant Consideration Time. Places will be offered to notified reserves on the day if available.

ii. Swimmers/reserves notified that they have been accepted for the long distance events MUST register their intention to compete 30 minutes prior to the start of that event at the Recorders' Desk on the day of the swim. Failure to register in person 30 minutes prior to the start of the relevant event will forfeit the right to compete and reserves who have registered their desire to swim on the day will be offered the opportunity to compete.

(f) **Specified competition period**

Submitted times must have been achieved within the specified period of 21 February 2015 to 22 January 2016.

**6. Finals and Heat Declared Events**

- i. Finals will be held for all 50m and 100m events; the last three heats of events with Finals will be cyclically seeded.
- ii. All other events will be Heat Declared Winner (HDW); all heats of HDW events will be spearhead seeded.

**7. Senior/Junior Champions**

**(a) Age Group Finals**

- i. The Senior Champion of each event with Finals will be the competitor returning the overall fastest time in the Finals for that event regardless of age.
- ii. The Junior Champion of each event with Finals will be the Junior swimmer returning the fastest time for a Junior swimmer in the Finals for that event. If no Junior swimmer qualifies for Finals, the Junior Champion for that event will be the Junior competitor returning the fastest time from the heats of that event.

**(b) Heat Declared Events (HDW)**

- i. The Senior Champion of each HDW event will be the competitor returning the overall fastest time regardless of age.
- ii. The Junior Champion of each HDW event will be the Junior swimmer returning the fastest time for that event.

**(c) Junior Champions**

- i. Junior swimmers and Junior Champions are competitors under 16 years of age on 31 December 2016.
- ii. Swimmers who are under 16 years of age at midnight on the DAY of a swim may claim a Junior County Record.

**8. Awards**

**(a) HDW Medals & Awards**

- i. Male and female age bands for the purposes of awards in these Competitions are: 10 yrs, 11 yrs, 12 yrs, 13 yrs, 14 yrs, 15 yrs, and 16/over.
- ii. Medals will be awarded for first, second and third place\* (see 2016 Entry Conditions 8(a)iv for exceptions) in each of the designated age bands for all individual events and for first, second and third place in each relay event.
- iii. Medals will be awarded from the Finals of all events in which there are Age Group Finals and from the heats of all HDW events. If no swimmers of an age band designated for awards qualify for Finals, medals for that age band will be awarded from the results of the heats of that event.
- iv. Medals will be awarded for first, second and third place and ribbons for each of 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> place in each of the designated age bands for the 1500m Freestyle and 800m Freestyle events.
- v. Medals will be awarded to the top three placed disability competitors in each event. Placing shall be determined on a multi-disability basis of the three swimmers in each sex who either break the World Record by the greater amount or are nearest to the World Record within their own classification. If less than four swimmers participate in any one event then the minus one ruling shall NOT apply.
- vi. Swimmers may collect events medals and awards for HDW events and Finals from the Presentation Table once the results have been announced. There will be no formal presentation of medals and awards.
- vii. HDW and Finals medals and awards must be collected from the Presentation Table during the competitions. The Presentation Table will close 15 minutes after the results of the final event of the Competitions have been published. Uncollected medals and awards will not be posted or made available for collection after the Competitions.

**(b) Championships Medals & Trophies**

- i. Senior Championships and Junior Championships medals will be awarded for the overall first, second and third places from the Finals for that event and each HDW event.
- ii. Senior and Junior Champions will be formally presented with County trophies where applicable.
- iii. Presentation of Championships medals and trophies will be made according to the published timetable for the Championships.
- iv. Swimmers who do not make themselves available will not be presented with their award.

**(c) Performance Awards**

- i. Performance Awards will be presented according to points accrued for heat swims from events categories.
- ii. Performance Awards events categories are:
  - Best Sprint (Best 50m swim)
  - Best 100 (Best 100m swim)
  - Best Form (Best 200m Butterfly *or* 200m Backstroke *or* 200m Breaststroke)
  - Best Distance (Best 200m *or* 400m *or* 800m *or* 1500m Freestyle)
  - Best Medley (Best 100IM *or* 200IM *or* 400IM)
- iii. Overall performance points will be calculated from a combination of Best Sprint, Best 100, Best Form, Best Distance and Best Medley. Points are not accumulative; only the greatest number of points achieved for one swim in each category will be taken into consideration.
- iv. Medals will be awarded to the top eight male and female winners in each of the following age groups: 10 yrs, 11 yrs, 12 yrs, 13 yrs and 14 yrs.

- v. Performance Awards will be made to the overall winner in each of the Performance Awards qualifying age groups.
- vi. There will be no medals or awards for category winners.
- vii. Presentation of awards will be made as time permits and in accordance to the published timetable.

## **9. Presentations**

- (a) Presentations will only be made to recipients wearing suitable poolside club clothing and which complies with the current ASA Child Protection Policy.
- (b) Trophies, medals and awards will only be presented to recipients who have won those awards.
- (c) The Promoter reserves the right not to present awards if the recipient does not comply with clause 10(a) and 10(b) or who does not make themselves available in a timely manner for presentation. The Promoter's decision is final.

## **10. County trophies**

- (a) County trophies shall be held by the winner (or in the event of a minor, by the winner's parent/guardian) as bailee for Dorset County ASA.
- (b) Trophies shall be returned engraved and in a clean condition at the request of the Trophies Controller or a Dorset County ASA Executive Officer and no later than 11 months from the date of the relevant competition, whichever is the sooner.
- (c) Failure or late return of a trophy as requested shall attract a fine, declared annually by the Principal County Officers. Any fine shall be the responsibility of the individual or, in the case of a club/team trophy, the club/team shall be responsible.
- (d) Engraving of trophies is the responsibility of the individual or, in the case of a club/team trophy, the club/team. Trophies that are not returned suitably engraved shall be engraved by Dorset County AA at the expense of the individual, club or team concerned. Any individuals/clubs in arrears for engraving costs must resolve outstanding debts before participating in future County competitions.

## **11. Club Team Points**

Points will be awarded for all entered teams for Team Relays and for all individual swimmers placed first to eighth in their respective Age Groups as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place = 8 points descending to 1 point = 8<sup>th</sup> place. Where a swimmer has dual recognition, he/she may represent only one Club, which shall be the Club named on the entry form. Team Points will be displayed at strategic times throughout the Competitions.

## **12. Code of Conduct**

All swimmers shall comply with the DCASA Code of Conduct and the County further reserves the right to take disciplinary action against the swimmer(s) concerned and/or the swimmers' Clubs.

## **13. Health Declaration**

To ensure that adequate safety procedures and protocols are observed, and the safety and well-being of all swimmers, all associated medical conditions must be declared on a Health Information Form together with the management plan for the condition. The Declaration shall be made by the swimmer/parent/guardian for the sole use of those persons with responsibility for health and safety during the Competitions. The content of the declaration will remain confidential. The forms of those swimmers who compete in the Dorset County Championships 2016 will be held on file until completion of the Dorset County Development Competition 2016.

## **14. Poolside personnel**

Only duly authorised personnel, and including any person accompanying a swimmer with a Functional Ability Card or Certificate of Swimming Disability, who are registered on the ASA/Clubs Child Protection Lists and competitors shall be allowed poolside.

## **15. Spectators**

Entry will be free and subject to the limit of accommodation at the respective venue. There will be a charge of £5.00 for spectator programmes.
